# Galway One World Centre

The Galway One World Centre (GOWC) is a Development Education Resource Centre set up in 1992. It carries out education and training in both the formal (schools & universities) and non-formal (community & youth groups, general public) sectors.

## Formal Sector Work

This year we had to cancel our in-career Development Course as we had too few bookings. Due to interest we ran a teacher training course for teachers of primary schools in South Galway.

We also continued to link with SUAS: apart from organising their six week evening course in Autumn 2006, we also participated in their annual conference.

In order to improve our training delivery, we carried out learning needs analyses with participants at SUAS, teachers in South Galway and people involved with the Centre

The GOWC continued to provide modules on global development for both the H.Dip. Ed. Course and the ALIVE programme at NUI Galway.

## Non-formal Sector

As we had a number of staff changes during 2006, we decided not to run a Learning Circle ourselves, instead we provided support and inputs to a Learning Circle run by a former Learning Circle participant in Oughterard.

We also developed & implemented a training project looking at gender based violence with AkiDwA.

This year saw the re-introduction of our "Community Conversation Programme", a project aimed at increasing awareness amongst the general public. As part of this programme, we organised film screenings, a series of monthly debates, and supported LAW 2006.

## Networking

The GOWC believes that it is very important to link with like-minded organisations and campaigns at local and national level. We continue to participate in:
